- 6. Who was Bob Haldeman and what was his job?
- 7. How did Butterfield describe his job? What was he responsible for in the Nixon White House?
- 8. What surprised Butterfield while working in the Nixon White House? Explain the examples he used to illustrate his point.
- 9. Describe what is happening in the picture on page 1249. How do the people look? What can you infer about what is happening?
- 10. When, where, and how was the taping system installed? According to Butterfield, who installed the system, and what was their opinion of taping systems in general? (see footnote 1 page 1251)
- 11. What did Butterfield think of John Dean's testimony? Did Butterfield think the taping system would confirm Dean's testimony?
- 12. What personal reason did Butterfield have for telling the truth?
- 13. According to Butterfield, how extensive was the recording system? (be specific)
- 14. How did Butterfield and preface his response to Don Sanders's question, and why?
- 15. How was Butterfield treated by the Nixon White House after he testified before the Senate Watergate Committee? The Ford White House?
